**GET TO KNOW YOUR MACHINE**

**Sewing Machine Classes** are offered by special appointment to persons who have purchased a sewing machine from The Sewing Center. This class includes the basics of machine operation and the best methods for using all the accessories of your machine. Bring your machine with all the attachments and we'll show you how to use it. For others needing a date with their machine, the cost is \$50.00 per lesson, and is 2 to 3 hours long.

**Learn Your Serger Classes** are free for those who have purchased a serger from The Sewing Center. For those that didn't purchase their machine from The Sewing Center, it is \$50.00 per class. Bring your serger and accessories and learn all that it can do and learn to do it efficiently.

**Elna e740/e720/7200/7300 and Janome Horizon Class:** Free for those who purchased their machine from The Sewing Center. For those that didn't purchase their machine from The Sewing Center, it is \$50.00 per class.

- ◆ **Applique** introduces the applique stitches and features of the Elna e740/e720/7200/7300 and Janome Horizon.
- ◆ **Heirloom Techniques** introduces the heirloom stitches and features of the Elna e740/e720/7200/7300 and Janome Horizon.
- ◆ **Accessories** introduces the standard and optional accessories available to the Elna e740/e720/7200/7300 and the Janome Horizon.

**Elna/Janome Embroidery Machine Classes:** Free for those who purchased their machine from The Sewing Center. For those that didn't purchase their machine from The Sewing Center, it is \$50.00 per class.

- ◆ **Elna 9500/9600 and Janome 10000/11000 Quilting 1&2:** Please bring your AQ Hoop and SQ Hoop along with clear acrylic insert and gridded template. If you have a Clothsetter, bring it also.
- ◆ **Elna 9500/9600 and Janome 10000/11000 Large Layouts:** Please bring your SQ and ST Hoops and gridded templates. If you have a Clothsetter, bring it also.
- ◆ **Elna 8300/8600:** For all classes bring your large hoop and gridded template.

**SEWING**

**Adult Basic Sew:** 4 sessions, \$50.00 includes book, supplies extra. This class is designed to teach the novice or to reacquaint the reluctant sewer with basic clothing construction. Sewing projects are individually geared to each student's skills and desires. You will learn many speed tips and correct measuring techniques of the pattern and body for a more accurate fit. Come sew with us.

**Learn to Make Pants:** 4 sessions, \$50.00, supplies extra. This class is designed to teach the sewist the techniques used to fit and construct pants. You will learn how to measure your body and draft your pattern for a more accurate fit.

**Tailoring Techniques:** **CLASS IN PROGRESS. Sessions 5 and 6 scheduled for January 2012.** BRING YOUR MACHINE AND ACCESSORIES/ATTACHMENTS. Learn the fitting and sewing techniques and notions that are involved in creating a tailored garment.

### QUILTING

**Sudoku Quilt:** 2 sessions, \$30.00, supplies extra. Using a basic 9-patch block, you will easily assemble a lap quilt based on the popular Sudoku puzzles. You will learn how to plan each block using 9 different fabrics and colors. The Sudoku pattern is a fantastic way to practice new color combinations; if you are unsure what colors go together, this class will help you with your “color coordination”. At the first class you will use crayons or markers to test and design your finished quilt. Then you will begin piecing your blocks. In the second class, you will learn how to pin the completed top with batting and backing and begin machine quilting your quilt. You will also learn how to cut and stitch your binding.

**Techniques of Quilting:** \$125.00, bring your machine with accessories and basic sewing kit. This class will meet approximately 15 times during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2012. This class is **not** machine specific. We will cover machine piecing techniques. Learn how to select quality fabric and appropriate batting and backing along with how to bind a quality, finished product. This sequence of classes contains a vast variety of skill building techniques from beginning to end! **CLASS SIZE IS LIMITED! FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED!**

**Turning Twenty – a Beginner’s Quilt:** 3 sessions, \$55.00 includes book, supplies extra. This quilt is a good one to gain confidence in cutting, piecing and quilting. This particular quilt can be made scrappy or themed with baby, holiday, or some other novelty fabric.

### EMBROIDERY

**Principles of Digitizing:** Free for those who purchased their Floriani software from The Sewing Center. For those who did not purchase from The Sewing Center, it is \$15.00. This is an introduction to digitizing a basic design to familiarize you with the properties of a well digitized design. Bring your laptop.  
**Prerequisite: Floriani Embroidery Software Boot Camp.**

**Floriani Embroidery Software Boot Camp:** Free for those who purchased their Floriani software from The Sewing Center. For those who did not purchase from The Sewing Center, it is \$15.00. Bring your laptop with software installed. This class will cover the working environment of the Floriani Embroidery Software. Menus, tools and options will be covered in depth so you can move on to digitizing your own designs or altering existing designs in your own design library.

### **CLASS POLICIES**

**PRE-ENROLLMENT:** Required for ALL classes. A class will not be held if there are fewer than two students.

**REFUNDS:** If you cancel one week prior to class you will receive a full refund. If you cancel within 6 days of class you will receive credit towards another class or store merchandise only.

**CLASS ATTENDANCE ISSUES:** **Please** be mindful of starting class times. The stated class time means you have your machine and supplies ready so the instructor can start the class. Arriving late or unprepared with regards to machine, accessories, etc. means a delay for everyone attending the class. Unpreparedness or tardiness turns a two hour class into a three hour class that many did not schedule themselves for including the instructor. Please arrive 10-15 minutes early so your questions and issues may be addressed and you can set up your sewing space prior to the start of class. Thank you.

**CELL PHONES:** **Please** be respectful of others around you. If you must be available via cell phone during class, please excuse yourself from the classroom during lectures and demonstrations

**BASIC SEWING/QUILTING KIT:** Bring scissors, pins, tape measure, fabric markers, rotary cutters, mat, safety pins.

**USE OF SEWING CENTER EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES:** There will be an **additional charge of \$5.00** to use our machines and/or supplies.

**CHILDREN:** Please do not bring your children with you without permission from the instructor **prior to class.**

**CANCELLATIONS OR INCLEMENT WEATHER:** If we cancel or postpone a class, you will have the choice of receiving a full refund on the class fee or full credit. Classes will be cancelled if road conditions are hazardous. If you are not sure if class will be held, **PLEASE CALL.**
